

### MISSION STATEMENT

The Sherri Arnold Graham Foundation is a not-forprofit, 501 (c)(3) multicultural and interdenominational organization passionately committed to reducing the incidence and mortality from breast cancer among all people. In serving all people, this Foundation responds with culturally sensitive materials for minority women and men who have disproportionate awareness, healthcare access, treatment options and support systems.

The 2009 Breast Cancer projections are alarming for the minority and majority populations (females and males included):

- 1.2 million cases worldwide
- 240,000 new cases in the United States
- 2,000 cases among men in the U.S.
- A woman is diagnosed with breast cancer every 3 minutes

However, "Awareness & Support Campaigns through Missions" can replace fear with faith.

Breast Cancer is a global epidemic. While breast cancer involves many mysteries, one clear fact is that the development and mortality rates differ among ethnic groups. Medical authorities unanimously agree that the disparity is largely due to late stage diagnosis subsequent to access barriers such as screening facilities, mammography, and health insurance.

The Sherri Arnold Graham Foundation works to reverse the incidence of late stage diagnosis and the corresponding health disparities through "Awareness Campaigns, Health Education, and Free Mammography Outreach." In the event of a breast cancer storm, this Foundation serves as a lighthouse to undergird families in crisis with compassionate support.

The operational methodology of this ministry enterprise is called "Lighthouse Communications," whereby we relay healthcare information to persons in crisis or at risk. Our services and literature are Free of Charge and available in both English and Spanish.
